
## **DualMinds PRESENTS**

## Tuesdays & Sundays



ONE CAN DEFINITELY say Daniel Arnold and Medina Hahn are young artists to watch. Graduates of the University of Alberta's BFA Acting program, they brought their play *Tuesdays & Sundays* to the Vancouver Fringe in 2001, where it was entirely sold out, before being invited to be staged as a held-over "Pick of the Fringe" production. It was included in *The Vancouver Sun*'s Best of the Year.

Since then, they have performed this humorous-yet-heartbreaking love story (which they also wrote) all across the country. "It's been staged across the country, from B.C. to Nova Scotia, including runs at Ottawa's National Arts Centre, in Toronto and Edmonton, and hailed repeatedly as a Top Ten Production of the Year."

Internationally, Arnold and Hahn have toured the multiaward winning *Tuesdays & Sundays* to the Edinburgh Festival, Prague, New Mexico, and New York, where it won the New York Fringe award Outstanding Overall Production, and their recent Off-Off-Broadway remount was listed in the New York Sun's BEST OF 2006 alongside long-running Broadway and Tony Award-winning shows!

Arnold and Hahn, now living in Vancouver, are starting to make their mark locally. Arnold appeared in the FirehallGateway co-production *Einstein's Gift* and more recently in Blackbird Theatre's *The Triumph of Love*. Hahn has appeared on TV's *The 4400* and *The Collector*. They also made the short film *The Janitors*, which Arnold co-wrote and directed and Hahn starred in alongside William B. Davis (Smoking Man from *The X-Files*). Their new stage play *Any Night* is currently being developed by the Vancouver Playhouse and will premiere in the spring of 2008, produced by Arnold and Hahn's new company DualMinds.

Meanwhile, local film producer Clare Hodge has optioned Tuesdays & Sundays, a screenplay to be penned by Arnold and Hahn, and co-produced by UK's Slate Films (producers of Academy Award-winning The Last King of Scotland).

Tuesdays & Sundays was broadcast on CBC and BBC Radio and has just been published by Dramatic Publishing, but you can see it live this August 7 – 19 at the Waterfront Theatre. Reserve early! Don't miss your chance to see these rising stars shine.
