

TUESDAYS AND SUNDAYS

This sweet and tortuous depiction of doomed 19th-century lovers and their rural community had a two-day stint in February, but now returns for the extended run it so richly deserves. Written and performed with great emotional intelligence by Daniel Arnold and Medina Hahn, *Tuesdays & Sundays* is a spare 50-minute depiction of a boy and girl caught up by lust and drowned by the tides of societal demand.

William and Mary are raised to be respectable young adults, but the blaze of passion and an unplanned pregnancy ensure that respectability becomes a cruel master with harsh demands. Based on a true story from 1887 PEI, it's easily one of the best plays running this year, and its return engagement is a boon for theatregoers. » Aug. 7 to 19. \$14 to \$20.
